## **Web-based Information Science Education**

at the iSchool at Syracuse

As a founding member of the Web-based Information Science Education (WISE) Consortium, the iSchool at Syracuse offers students in the Masters in Library and Information Science (LIS) program access to highly specialized courses from global leaders in online LIS education. This collaboration expands the collection of elective courses available at Syracuse, allowing students to explore their interests beyond the limits of the traditional curriculum.

Each semester, students may choose from several WISE courses, with topics ranging from International Librarianship to poetry and children's services (see sample list on back). After being accepted into a WISE course, students register directly through Syracuse University; payment and course credit is processed like any other graduate level course. Since capacity in WISE courses is limited, students are encouraged to check the iSchool website early in the enrollment period for course details.

WISE students engage in rich discussions with classmates from around the world, while studying with expert instructors who are dedicated to fostering a productive online learning environment.

## WISE Enrollment Request Process

**Review Selected Courses:** On the iSchool Website, go to "Course Schedules" and selecting "WISE Courses" under "Type"

**Obtain permission from SU:**

**View additional course details and request enrollment:**

1. Go to [www.wiseeducation.org](http://www.wiseeducation.org)
2. Login: Username: su-student  
Password: orange
3. Select the appropriate semester and click on "View Classes"
4. Click on "View Details" next to the course you are interested in
5. Review the details and disclaimer carefully and click on "Request Enrollment in This Class"
6. Enter your information and click on "Submit"
7. Your request has been entered and you will hear back from WISE at the start of the enrollment deadline, or within 1 business day if the enrollment deadline has passed.

Spring Semester: November 20

Summer Semester: March 20

Fall Semester: April 25

## PLEASE NOTE

### iSchool Requirements:

Good academic and financial standing  
Completion of one iSchool online course

**Multiple Requests:** If you enter multiple requests, enter your preference order on the enrollment request form

**SU Registration:** If you are accepted into a WISE course, you must register through the iSchool for IST 600, Special Topics. You will be contacted with a 5-digit course number to use for MySlice registration.

**Course Tools:** You will receive course tool login information from the school hosting your WISE course. If you have not received this information 2 weeks prior to the course start date, please contact [support@wiseeducation.org](mailto:support@wiseeducation.org)

**Course Details:** Pay careful attention to course dates (which vary by school), residencies, and pre-requisites listed in the course details on the WISE website

**Grading:** Allow 2 weeks from the end date of the course for grades to be available. Check that this schedule will not interfere with graduation plans or financial aid, etc.
