Syracuse University Army Scholarship for the School of Information Studies

The Army Scholarship for the School of Information Studies will be offered to a current student or graduate of one of the following programs:

- FA53 Information Systems Manager
- FA24 Telecommunication Engineer

at the United States Army Signal Center, Leader College for Information Technology (LCIT).

The School of Information Studies at Syracuse University will offer a **50% tuition scholarship** to an officer attending one of the following programs:

- Master's of Science in Information Management
- Executive Master's of Science in Information Management
- Master's of Science Telecommunications and Network Management

The scholarship will be granted for one year and will be renewable for a second year based on performance. The Army Scholar will be charged with the following duties:

- He/she will help to disseminate information about our programs and announcements.
- He/she will also serve as a resource to respond to questions from fellow military personnel.

The scholarship selection committee will be a combination of Syracuse and LCIT representatives. The application will include:

1. Letter of recommendation from a current or former supervisor (LTC or above) that addresses support of the officer's education program and comments on the officer's ability to execute the duties of an Army Scholar for Syracuse University.
2. A 500 word essay in response to the question: *"How will your selected choice of study enable you to better serve your country and your profession"*.

The application for Summer or Fall 2012 terms is due **May 1, 2012**. The application will be available by February 2012 and should be submitted online at <http://ischool.syr.edu/signalcenter> . Applications for the scholarship will only be reviewed if an admission application has also been submitted.
